RÉSUMÉ

L'enquête par grappes à indicateurs multiples (MICS) a été menée en 2022 par L'Institut National de la Statistique et des Etudes Economiques et Démographiques (INSEED) en collaboration avec nos partenaires techniques et financiers plus particulièrement l'UNICEF, dans le cadre du programme mondial des enquêtes MICS. Réalisée avec l'appui technique du Fonds des Nations Unies pour l'enfance (UNICEF), elle a bénéficié d'un financement du gouvernement, du soutien technique et financier de l'UNICEF et de la Banque Mondiale à travers du Projet « Compass » du Ministère de la Santé. Le programme mondial des enquêtes MICS a été élaboré par l'UNICEF dans les années 1990 en tant que programme international d'enquêtes auprès des ménages qui vise à soutenir les pays dans la collecte de données comparables au niveau international sur un large éventail d'indicateurs relatifs à la situation des enfants et des femmes. Les enquêtes MICS mesurent les indicateurs clés qui permettent aux pays de produire des données en vue de leur utilisation dans les politiques, les programmes et les plans de développement nationaux, et de suivre les progrès vers les Objectifs de Développement Durable (ODD) et d'autres engagements convenus au niveau international.

L'enquête MICS Comores en 2022 a pour objectifs principaux :

- De fournir des données de haute qualité pour évaluer la situation des enfants, des adolescents, des femmes et des ménages dans le MICS Comores, 2022 ;
- De fournir les données nécessaires au suivi des progrès vers les objectifs nationaux, comme base pour les actions futures ;
- De collecter des données désagrégées pour l'identification des disparités, afin d'orienter les politiques visant à l'inclusion sociale des plus vulnérables ;
- De valider les données provenant d'autres sources et les résultats d'interventions ciblées ;
- De générer des données sur les indicateurs nationaux et mondiaux des ODD ;
- De générer des données comparables au niveau international pour évaluer les progrès réalisés dans différents domaines et de déployer des efforts supplémentaires dans les domaines qui nécessitent une plus grande attention ;
- De générer des données sur les comportements et les attitudes qui ne sont pas disponibles dans d'autres sources de données.

Echantillonnage

PROCÉDURE D'ÉCHANTILLONNAGE

L'échantillon pour l'enquête MICS Comores, 2022 a été conçu pour fournir des estimations concernant un grand nombre d'indicateurs sur la situation des enfants et des femmes au niveau national/zone/sous-population, pour les zones urbaines, dont Moroni la capitale du pays, et rurales, et pour les îles (Mwali, Ndzuwani et Ngazidja). Les zones urbaines et rurales au sein de chaque île ont été identifiées comme les principales strates d'échantillonnage et l'échantillon de ménages a été conçu à deux degrés sauf dans deux domaines (Moroni et Mwali) dans lesquelles un tirage aléatoire stratifié par milieu (urbain-rural) a été effectué. Dans chaque strate de Ndzuwani et le reste de Ngazidja, un nombre spécifique de zones de dénombrement de recensement de 2017 a été systématiquement sélectionné avec une probabilité proportionnelle à la taille. Après la mise à jour de la liste des ménages dans les zones de dénombrement sélectionnées, un échantillon de 20 ménages a été tiré de façon aléatoire dans chaque grappe. Par contre pour les deux domaines Moroni et Mwali, un tirage aléatoire systématique a été effectué dans chaque strate sur la liste des ménages obtenue après le dénombrement des ménages dans toutes les ZDs de l'ensemble des strates. La taille finale de l'échantillon est de 6 800 ménages. Comme l'échantillon n'est pas auto-pondéré, des poids d'échantillon sont utilisés pour rapporter les résultats de l'enquête.
